He seemed to know all the projects he worked on well and he could describe what exactly he worked on.

He could answer all the questions I asked him on his projects well.

He has good understanding of distributed computing concepts e.g. map-reduce based computation.

He could answer all the questions/problems I asked him based on map-reduce.

 - *I asked him about some of his prior experience and he very clearly described a security-related project that was used to detect advertising click-throughs by malicious agents (e.g., a program to artificially click through advertisements). His explanation showed good technical knowledge of security concepts, client-server architecture, application-server technologies and standards (such as using Servlet filters), as well as good presentation skills. He answered my follow-up questions on the spot very well about how malicious agents were discovered, e.g., whether the browser agent is used, whether it is rule-based, IP address-based, frequency-based and so forth. This showed a good breadth of experience and general CS knowledge.*

After that I asked him three coding questions that he answered quickly. His code was written cleanly and was well thought out from the beginning. He used good object-oriented structure, proper class names and syntax, and covered the error cases. In addition to answering correctly, he offered multiple solutions to some of the problems when I gave him new restrictions, such as using no extra storage. His solutions were creative, and he described the pros and cons of each. My conclusion from the coding questions was that he was a good problem solver and a very proficient programmer.

Finally, he was pleasant to talk to, polite, patient and gave me the impression that he would be easy to work with.
