Upon enrollment, Scholar success will be supported through tailored Personal and Career Counseling services and Employment Counseling Services. Once Scholars have completed the academic portion of the program, they will be prepared to pursue and attain employment status benefiting from MCC's technical training, Personal and Career Counseling, and Employer Engagement. MCC expects to place over 90% of those who complete the Flint Job Corps Scholars program into related employment or apprenticeship opportunities, and/or service in the military.
