National Youth Employment Coalition (NYEC) -


Membership organization consisting of providers, researchers, funders, policy folks, local government folks.

BROOKINGS JOB MOBILITY AND SMART GROWTH TOOLKIT

An interactive tool to help skill-building organizations and firms better understand low-wage workers and connect them to higher paying jobs.

Mobility Pathways visualizes data on over 250,000 real job-to-job transitions, tracing the common pathways into and out of 441 occupations across 130 industries at the national and city levels. It is the first element of a multipart toolkit to support job mobility and smart growth.
