KCC Job Corps will provide career preparation and training for young adults between the ages of 18 and 24 in communities with low young adult employment, high rates of poverty, school dropout rates, foster care placement, and other determinants of likely disconnection. Youths will gain industry knowledge and work experience, and have the opportunity to earn industry certifications, college credits, and/or enroll in KCC's maritime apprenticeship program. Supportive services will help youth overcome barriers that might otherwise lead to disconnection. Over 3 years, KCC Job Corps will serve 80 youths, place 55 in employment, 16 into college, two in apprenticeships, and at least one in the armed services. KCC has been delivering comprehensive career and technical training programs since 2009. Knowing that un- and under-employed, underserved, and disadvantaged job seekers come to us with unique needs, we have developed supplemental services that support retention, ultimately leading to sustainable and gainful employment or educational outcomes. Counseling services have included:

Personal and career counseling: individual and group counseling; screening for public assistance (health insurance, SNAP benefits, housing, etc.); referral to on-campus and community resources; development and progress of ISPs; transition (from training to education, job, and/or exit); tutoring and exam preparation; college enrollment; and career exploration.

Employment counseling: job searching; job application completion; resume and cover letter writing; interview preparation; internship; apprenticeship and job placement; development and progress of ISPs; and career planning (which includes educational services).
