## Skagit Valley College Job Corps Scholars Program

Skagit Valley College is a two-year community college in northwest Washington State accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. Together with the regional workforce development board, Northwest Workforce Council (NWC), the Job Corps Scholars Program will serve 80 Scholars over the 39-month project period. Target community served includes five counties: Island, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, and Whatcom counties, 31 school districts, and approximately 16 percent of the state's K-12 public school students.

Skagit Valley College Job Corps Scholars Program will enroll scholars in technical training programs offered at SVC. Scholars will work with a navigator to identify a training pathway, enroll in developmental coursework, and enroll in training. The Program is not residential. Support will be provided through community referrals and support services to secure housing, childcare, transportation, and personal and family needs. SVC requests \$1,186,900. Funds will be used to pay college tuition costs associated with training, provide support services, and fund academic navigators and career transition service specialists, ensuring a staff to student ratio of 20 to 1. The cost per participant is \$14,836.25. Given the low staff to student ratio, extensive experience delivering education and employment services, and the resources invested in the program, SVC expects a high training completion (separation) rate and low dropout rate.

NWC has extensive experience working with Job Corps-eligible youth through WIOA programs. All students will begin with developmental coursework to ensure college readiness, development of basic skills and college success skills, and identification of a training pathway.
