## ORDER DENYING FEE PETITION

Counsel for appellant has filed a fee petition in the amount of \$1,779.00.<sup>1</sup> The Board notes that all petitions for approval of fees for representatives' services are considered under the Board's statutory authority found at section 8127 of the Federal Employees' Compensation Act,<sup>2</sup> (FECA) and under its *Rules of Procedure* found at 20 C.F.R. § 501.9(e).

As required by the Board's regulations, appellant has been afforded written notice of the fee requested and provided an opportunity to comment on the fee petition.<sup>3</sup>

As noted above, counsel submitted a fee petition requesting approval of fees in the amount of \$1,779.00 with regard to the appeal assigned Docket No. 18-0210, which was filed with the Board on November 7, 2017. Attached to the fee petition, however, is a billing statement totaling \$1,146.08 for services performed before the Board in 2015 in relation to the appeal assigned

Docket No. 16-0329. The fee petition requests approval of services from November 5 through December 15, 2015, and documents 3.01 hours spent in connection with the appeal before the Board at \$400.00 per hour for Thomas Uliase, Esquire and \$75.00 per hour for legal secretary Cherryl Leonardo.

Thus, the Board, having considered the fee petition and the submitted supporting documentation, denies the fee petition.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT** the fee petition in the amount of \$1,779.00 is denied and may be resubmitted to the Board within 60 days of the date of this order.
