

ORDER OF CASE CLOSING

On December 7, 2020, the Plaintiff, Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs, United States Department of Labor (OFCCP) filed a Notice of Intent and Request to Close Case with the Administrative Review Board. ¹ The Administrative Law Judge's decision arose under Executive Order 11246 (30 Fed. Reg. 12319), as amended. The Executive Order's implementing regulations are found at 41 C.F.R. Part 60. On October 5, 2020, the Board issued an Order Granting Extension of Time allowing OFCCP to file exceptions on or before December 7, 2020.
