Pursuant to section 501.9(e) of the Board’s *Rules of Procedure*,¹ Gregory A. Hall, Esquire, Denver, Colorado, counsel for appellant, filed an application for approval of a fee in the sum of Six Thousand and Sixty Dollars (\$6,060.00) for legal services performed on behalf of appellant before the Board. A statement accompanying the application listed 30.30 hours of work at \$200.00 per hour.

Appellant was provided an opportunity by the Board to comment on the requested fee, but no response was received.

The Board has duly considered the statement from the representative as to the extent and nature of the necessary work performed before the Board on behalf of appellant and has evaluated the fee request based on the usefulness of the representative’s services, the nature and complexity of the appeal, the capacity in which the representative has appeared, the actual time spent in connection with the Board appeal and customary local charges for similar services and
