

Notice of Endangered Status For Operating Engineers Local No. 825 Pension Plan

This is to inform you that on September 28, 2012 the Plan actuary certified to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and also the Board of Trustees, that the Plan is in endangered status for the Plan Year beginning July 1, 2012. Federal law requires that you receive this notice.

Endangered Status

The Plan is considered to be in endangered status because it has funding problems. More specifically, the Plan's actuary determined that the Plan's funded percentage is less than 80%.

Funding Improvement Plan

Federal law requires pension plans in endangered status to adopt a Funding Improvement Plan (FIP) aimed at restoring the financial health of the plan. On March 19, 2012 the Trustees adopted a FIP which increases the hourly employer contribution rate for outside construction employees from \$5.75 to \$6.00 effective July 1, 2011 and reduces the monthly benefit accrual rate from 1.35% to 1.00% effective January 1, 2011.
