and television broadcasts to reach a wide audience.

The Global March undertook activities in at least eight countries to raise awareness on child labor and conduct meetings with government and civil society to discuss alternatives to child labor;

Redeveloped website and measured web usage

Organized awareness-raising events at international forums on labor rights and other meetings of prominent international and national policymakers;

Produced and disseminate media materials addressing child labor.
