- Reduce the level of employment related discrimination against persons living with HIV/AIDS.

- 3. Support the formation of a tripartite advisory committee consisting of representatives of workers, employers, and government to strengthen stakeholder collaboration to ensure sustainability.
- 4. Facilitate the formation of steering committees at private sector sites.
- 5. Assess the impact of HIV/AIDS on workplace productivity.
- 6. Identify best practices.
