The issue is whether appellant has met his burden of proof to establish that his current back condition and disability on or after December 19, 1996 was causally related to his accepted January 25, 1988 employment injury.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of appellant on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the decision of the hearing representative of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs dated June 22, 1998 which affirmed the Office's July 15, 1997 decision is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the Office hearing representative.
