The issue is whether the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs properly terminated appellant's compensation effective July 14, 1998 due to his refusal of an offer of suitable work.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of the parties on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the decision of the hearing representative of the Office dated and finalized August 20, 1999 is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the Office hearing representative.
