DECISION and ORDER

The issue is whether the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs properly determined that appellant's wage-earning capacity was represented by the position of surveillance system monitor.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of the parties on appeal and the entire case record.
