#### **DECISION** and **ORDER**

## Before WILLIE T.C. THOMAS, MICHAEL E. GROOM, PRISCILLA ANNE SCHWAB

The issue is whether appellant has established that she sustained a recurrence of disability commencing November 3, 1998, causally related to her right thoracic outlet syndrome and costo clavicular syndrome.
