The issue is whether the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs met its burden of proof to terminate appellant's compensation effective March 4, 1999 on the grounds that he had no disability due to his employment injury after that date.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of the parties on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the decision of the hearing representative of the Office dated and finalized August 31, 1999 is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the Office hearing representative.

The August 31, 1999 decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs is affirmed.
