Comments during these town hall sessions will be limited to two minutes each. No written comments will be accepted at these sessions; however, you may submit written comments as follows:

- Affirmative Action & Nondiscrimination Obligations of Contractors and Subcontractors; Evaluation of Recruitment and Placement Results under Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act. This regulation protects individuals with disabilities from employment discrimination by federal contractors and subcontractors. - Affirmative Action & Nondiscrimination Obligations of Contractors and Subcontractors; Evaluation of Recruitment and Placement Results under the Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act (VEVRAA). Under VEVRAA, federal contractors and subcontractors are prohibited from discrimination on the basis of veteran status. Projected Publication date for Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM): 12/2010. - Construction Contractor Affirmative Action Requirements. OFCCP regulations at 41 CFR Part 60-4, require Federal and federally assisted construction contractors to provide equal opportunity in all construction trades. Projected Publication date for Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM): 1/2011. Please email: OFCCP-Regulatory-Agenda-EO-Construction@dol.gov
