SUBJECT: Change 1 to Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 15-22: Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth Activities Program Allotments for Program Year (PY) 2023; PY 2023 Allotments for the Wagner-Peyser Act Employment Service (ES) Program; and PY 2023 Allotments of Workforce Information Grants to States

1. **Purpose.** To provide information to outlying areas (American Samoa, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, Republic of Palau, and U.S. Virgin Islands) on submitting a single application for WIOA title I Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth Activities program allotments for PY 2023.
2. **Action Requested.** Outlying areas must follow the requirements in this guidance, designated in the attachment as Appendix VII, to obtain the federal funds needed to manage their WIOA title I programs as a consolidated grants.
3. **Summary and Background.**
 - a. Summary – TEGL No. 15-22 indicated the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) would provide additional guidance specifically to outlying areas, and this Change 1 provides that guidance.
 - b. Background – TEGL No. 15-22, issued on April 21, 2023, announced PY 2023 WIOA state and outlying area allotments and provided guidance on how to request those funds. The *Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023*, allows outlying areas to submit a single application according to the requirements established by the Secretary for a consolidated grant for Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth funds.
4. **Instructions.** In TEGL No. 15-22, Appendices I through VI provided guidance, and Attachments A through K provided formula descriptions and allotment tables. This change 1 provides Appendix VII with specific instructions to outlying areas for a consolidated application and reporting requirements. Outlying areas must follow steps identified in Appendix VI if they are not consolidating the Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth funds.
