This grant provides a total of \$7,478,408 in 5311 FY 2020 federal funds, comprised of \$7,371,509 in FY2020 Section 5311 funds plus \$106,899 in FY2020 RTAP funds (the full apportionments of both types of funds).

The grant will fund operating assistance, project administration, state administration (comprising 10% of total apportionment), intercity bus (15% of 5311 apportionment) and preventive maintenance for eligible transit providers in Wyoming as well as \$106,899 of FY2020 Section 5311 RTAP funding for training and technical assistance.
