Can I pump breast milk at work?

Most nursing employees now have the right to reasonable break time and space to pump at work for up to one year after their child's birth.

What does my employer need to do?

Employers must provide **covered employees** with **space that is**:

- functional for pumping milk,
- shielded from view,
- free from intrusion,
- available as needed, AND
- NOT a bathroom.
