On November 23, 2011, claimant filed a timely notice of appeal of the administrative law judge's Supplemental Decision and Order Awarding Attorney's Fees and Costs on Remand and his Decision and Order on Reconsideration of Attorney Fees (2004-LHC-2359) which were filed in the Office of the District Director on October 12, 2011 and November 17, 2011, respectively. 33 U.S.C. §§919(e), 921(a); 20 C.F.R. §802.205(a). This appeal is assigned BRB No. 12-0115. 20 C.F.R. §802.210. All correspondence concerning this appeal must bear this number.

Claimant has also filed a Motion for Summary Decision, stating that he does not wish to appeal the substance of the administrative law judge's decisions on remand but seeks a final order so that he may challenge the Board's prior decision in this case. *Boroski v. DynCorp Int'l*, BRB No. 10-0438 (Mar. 15, 2011)(unpub.). We grant claimant's motion and affirm the administrative law judge's decisions on remand. *See generally Boone v. Newport News Shipbuilding* 

& *Dry Dock Co.*, 37 BRBS 1 (2003)(affirming issues previously decided based on law of the case doctrine).

Accordingly, the Supplemental Decision and Order Awarding Attorney's Fees and Costs on Remand and the Decision and Order on Reconsideration of Attorney Fees of the administrative law judge are affirmed.
