Application Executive Summary

GRTA requests to extend the expiration date to September 30, 2023, from September 30, 2020, for GRTA to have more time to award the ongoing procurement. The local Government Services Administration has forwarded the procurement documents to the Attorney General's Office for their final review. Guam law requires that any procurement with the value of \$500,000 or more must be approved by the AG's Office prior to the award.

GRTA anticipates that in the event that a protest is filled, GRTA gave ourselves ample allowance in case the procurement will be re-solicited. The procurement of these buses is crucial in supporting the GRTA paratransit service.

In addition, the Governor of Guam has directed the procurement department of the Government of Guam to assist Guam Regional Transit Authority to procure buses for paratransit and fixed-routes transit requirements. However, without funds from the grant, GRTA will not be able to buy buses. Without additional buses, the Governor is clearly aware that GRTA will have a tough time bringing persons with disabilities to the medical appointments, and workers without transportation to work.

This is the end of Amendment Number 1.

The FY 2017 federal funding are as follows: Section 5310 amounting to \$47,983 (Enhanced Mobility of Seniors & Individuals with Disabilities Grant Program), Section 5311 (b) (3) amounting to \$23,225 (Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP), Section 5339 amounting to \$500,000 are consolidated to Section 5311 amounting to \$846,278 for a grand total amounting to \$1,417,486 which will be used as operating assistance for GRTA's paratransit service, state or programs administration, and acquisition of rolling stocks, and purchase of communications system.

As per FTA C9040.1G, Page III-7, 3.a., a state or program administration funds totaling \$141,749 which is 10 percent of the combined total of FY 2017 Sections 5310, 5311, 5311 (b) (3), 5339 will be used by GRTA for partially funding the salaries and benefits of 2 (two) limited-term employees to administer all FTA grant programs in FY 2018 amounting to \$37,502, and for the partial funding of the purchase of communications system amounting to \$104,247.

In addition, as per FTA C9040.1G, Page III-11, 3.c., the FY 2017 Operating Assistance amounting to \$775,737 will be used for the expenditures incurred for the operational expenses of GRTA paratransit service in FY 2018.

GRTA earmarks the FY 2017 Section 5339 grant funds which is consolidated to FY 2017 Section 5311 amounting to \$500,000.00 to acquire 5 (five) new 14 seats ADA compliant gasoline fueled buses which are less than 30 ft. long.

The seniors & individuals with disabilities including the economically disadvantaged target populace of the island will reap the benefits of partially funding GRTA paratransit service which translates to more operating hours and committed federal funding. Moreover, with the acquisition of rolling stocks, GRTA will be able to expand its paratransit and fixed route services to the target populace and the general riding public. Further, with the partial funding of the communications system purchase, GRTA will be able to employ a transportation management system with computer-aided reservations, scheduling, and dispatching thereby making GRTA Dispatch Center more efficient and effective. Finally, all federal grant program requirements will be complied with thereby insuring continued funding for GRTA's paratransit service with the partial funding of the salaries and benefits of 2 (two) limited-term employees to administer the grant programs.
