Application Executive SummaryThis is a Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT) application for the remaining balance of

Section 5311 CARES Act funds awarded to Maine in the amount of \$7,283,794 for a program of projects to support rural transit in Maine.

On March 27, 2020, President Trump signed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act into law. The CARES Act provides emergency assistance and health care response for individuals, families and businesses affected by the COVID-19. The MaineDOT was apportioned \$24,554,813 in section 5311CARES Act funding (FTA Table 3 attached). MaineDOT was awarded \$17,271,019 in ME-2020-005-00 activities for CARES Act funding for Rural Providers in Maine. This grant will apply for the remaining apportionment of \$7,283,794 for rural providers in Maine.

These funds will be used for:
