Project Description

The Winnebago Tribe is applying to purchase a van to meet the growing transportation needs of individuals served by the Winnebago Tribal Transit program.

The new passenger van will be a 2019 T-350 LR, 148" wheelbase,15 passenger seats, privacy glass, exterior length running boards, heavy duty alternator, cruise control, rear window defogger, 50 state emissions, 9000# GVWR Package, 6-SPD auto select shift TR, 3.7L RIVCT V6 Engine, manual air conditioner, and Pewter Vinyl XL Trim.

The anticipated life of the 15 passenger vehicle is estimated to serve WTT in excess of 5 years.

The Van will serve as a backup and the new route that this vehicle will take is filling a gap that community members need reliable transportation for personal services as well as regularly schedule appointment for health care, and employment. Passengers on this route will include clients accessing education and employment opportunities and/or arrange by the Winnebago Human Services TANF office and tribal Education departments.

Project Benefits

The Winnebago Tribal Transit Program has continued to increase ridership year after year. Patrons/riders have increased since the inception of the service ten years ago. The service is beneficial to residents due to the ever increasing fuel costs. Our on-going growth of passengers has gone from 15,423 in 2009 to 29,018 to/from the Casino/Resort and 374 of the general public in 2018.

Based on the growth of the ridership the new van was designed to accommodate more individuals and provide shorter turn-around times with the most economical type vehicle to minimize operating costs. This route will be used for individuals who need to access grocery shopping without worry of food safety. Job growth in the region is improving and access to those jobs is attainable with the use of WTT's service. We have experienced an increase in the number of employees gaining employment at the Tribe's new hotel/resort on the Iowa side of the Reservation. Job growth continues to increase in our service area that tribal members and residents are taking advantage of and using the WTT as their source of transportation. Our community has also had an increase in the number of individuals purchasing new homes and these homes and there are plans for building more homes in our community within the next 5 years. We anticipate the number of patrons to continue to increase as the steady growth in population of our community continues.

The number of individuals impacted by our services is difficult to measure as we not only serve the residents of Thurston County, Nebraska, Native Americans in the Sioux City and South Sioux City area use the service to access healthcare at the Winnebago Tribe's 12 Clans Unity Hospital/Winnebago Comprehensive Healthcare Services. Both the Winnebago and Omaha Reservations make up a little more than the entirety of Thurston County, Nebraska.

Additional Information

The route the van will take is approximately 30 miles in length one way, providing access to employment, education, healthcare, and personal services including groceries for an estimated seventy-five people.
