Application Executive Summary

Amendment #1 - July 17, 2020

This is an Amendment for FFY 2020 Section 5311 CARES Act funds in the amount of \$6,413,177 (100% Federal Share). This application utilizes CARES Act funding to help respond to and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. Per the CARES Act, the grant requests 100% Federal Share. The application scope of work includes \$469,650 in Operating Assistance, \$354,418 in Intercity Operating Assistance, \$4,695,625 in Capital Assistance, and \$893,484 in Intercity Capital Assistance for rural transit Agencies statewide in Kentucky.

The total 5311 and 5340 apportionment is \$58,808,456, and there is a current balance of \$37,678,355. This Amendment decreases the total balance to \$31,265,178.

Total Revised Federal Share: \$29,307,278.

Currently, only \$2,797,418 (10.16%) of the 5311 CARES Act grant has been programmed for Intercity. Although 15% (\$8,821,268) of the total Apportionment has not yet been fully designated for Intercity, when the remaining apportionment balance is applied for, it will include at least another \$6,023,850 for Intercity. This will meet the requirement of 15% of the total 5311 CARES Act Apportionment to be spent on Intercity.

This is an FFY 2020 Section 5311 CARES Act application in the amount of \$22,894,101 (100% Federal Share)), this application utilizes CARES Act funding to help respond to and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. The application scope of work includes \$19,580,585 in Operating Assistance, \$1,549,516 in Intercity Operating Assistance, and \$1,764,000 in Appalachian Operating Assistance for rural transit Agencies statewide in Kentucky. Project Benefits

These rural transit agencies will provide transportation services statewide to the general public in the rural areas of Kentucky, including Appalachian Counties. Services will include transportation to jobs, medical/mental health appointments (including cancer treatment and dialysis), Veterans, shopping, etc. Intercity Bus services support the connection between non-urbanized areas and the larger regional/national system of intercity bus services.

Per the US Census, the poverty rate in Kentucky is 16.9% which means that approximately 1 out of ever 6 residents live in poverty. Higher than the national poverty rate of 11.8%, Kentucky ranks 47th in the nation. Due to COVID-19, many residents of Kentucky are now unemployed and need access to reliable transportation for medical care, groceries, prescriptions, and other necessities.

Transit Agencies, in Kentucky, serve a large portion of the Appalachian Region. 54 of Kentucky's 120 Counties are in the Appalachian Region. According to the last Poverty Report, published by the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC), the poverty rate across the combined Appalachian Region (Alabama, Kentucky, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia) was found to be 19.7%. However, this Report found that the state with the worst poverty rate in the Appalachian Region is Kentucky with a 25.4% rate in the Appalachian portion versus the rest of the state. The county in Kentucky with the highest poverty rate is Owsley County, an Appalachian County, with a poverty rate of 39.2%. Poverty is not based on unemployment numbers alone. One of the main factors found, in this Report, in regards to poverty in the Appalachian Region was that the employed population make significantly lower amounts of money than the rest of the United States. The people in this Region need adequate, affordable public transportation to survive.
