The total operating budget is \$365,290, with a Federal share of 90% (\$328,761), per the discretionary application.

The Lake Traverse Reservation is an impoverished rural area, with 21.3 percent of all individuals living below poverty level, so access to reliable, safe transportation is critical to individuals and families living in the area. According to 2012-2016 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates, the unemployment rate of the Reservation was 8 percent, double that of the United States.

The existing buses regularly serve, Agency Village, where the tribal headquarters is located, but the other six districts are visited only on a limited basis. The addition of two more vans to the Tribe's inventory would move them closer to the goal of regular service to the six reservation districts that are not regularly served at this time.

The Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate Tribe will purchase two transit vehicles to expand transit services across the region.

Project Benefits

The Lake Traverse Reservation covers a vast rural area. The Lake Traverse Reservation is an impoverished rural area, with 21.3 percent of all individuals living below poverty level, so access to reliable, safe transportation is critical to individuals and families living in the area. According to 2012-2016 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates, the unemployment rate of the Reservation was 8 percent, double that of the United States. Due to these high levels of poverty and unemployment, very few individuals have private cars, limiting their access to essential services and goods. The transit system is utilized frequently and by a vast number of reservation residents, increasing transportation efficiency and safety and improving mobility.

The addition of two additional buses will maintain mobility for a number of residents and fill an enormous gap in services, as it is currently the sole source of public transportation on the reservation. The purchase of two buses will allow the Tribe to maintain access to destinations and services, including maintenance of all current transit service contracts with human services, employment services, educational systems, and government entities. It ensures residents have critical access to healthcare, employment, educational and training opportunities that expand ladders of opportunity. Additionally, as seen by the ridership numbers provided, the transit program is utilized by a significant number of elderly and disabled adults as well as children, ensuring not just access to services and goods, but also increased safety for vulnerable populations.
