Application Executive Summary

This is an FFY 2021 Section 5311 Tribal CRRSAA funds grant application in the amount of \$96,694 (full apportionment). Per the CRRSSA funds, the grant requests 100% federal share. This application utilizes CRRSAA funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The CRRSAA funds will be used in support of the Tribe's transit service (known locally as DAR) which provides 73 hours per week of demand response transit service within an area encompassing the Southern Ute Tribal Campus, tribal enterprise locations, tribal neighborhoods, senior housing, tribal services including medical, education and recreation, plus shopping, social and family connections from January 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022. Additionally, funds will be used to support service to CR 521 north of Ignacio to Bayfield, where 2-year college and vocational classes are held.

FY21 ARP funds will fund DAR services from July 1, 2022 to September 30, 2022. FY21 5311 TTP Formula funds will fund the DAR services from October 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.
