Application Executive Summary

This is an FFY 2021 Section 5311 ARP Act application in the amount of \$1,592,018. This total includes 5311(b)(3) (RTAP) and 5311(f) (intercity) apportionments. Per the ARP Act, the grant requests 100% federal share. This application utilizes ARP Act funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The application scope of work includes project admin, operations, preventive maintenance, for 17 current subrecipients to fund a portion of one months' service. It also includes RTAP and dedicated intercity projects for current subrecipients and one intercity contractor to fund approximately 80% of the fiscal year's operations. Any funds not expended according to projections will be reallocated and expended prior to the expiration of ARP Act apportionments in September 2024.

The breakdown of operating expenses provided below were derived by subrecipient agencies based on current and historical spending in the respective categories. Budget estimates also took into account inflation factors and other adjustments to costs based on the changing landscape of individual expenses (i.e., hiring additional staff, etc.).

This award is being funded at 100% federal and does not include match dollars. However, the attached "Nevada ARPA POP (5311)" provides detailed match source/funding breakdown information.

- Award purpose: to provide relief to rural transit operators to maintain transit service throughout Nevada
- Activities to be performed: this award will fund transit operations including administrative and maintenance; intercity operations; and training and technical assistance activities.
- Expected outcomes: this award is expected to produce and preserve mobility among visitors to and residents of the state, with the residual effects of the pandemic it is expected that ridership numbers will begin to recover as transit providers get back to full operations at pre-COVID levels.
- Intended beneficiaries: mobility in rural areas is particularly important for those populations classified as most vulnerable, although all funded services under this award will serve the general public, transit propensity will be a key determinant in the level of benefit realized by each demographic. direct service to those seeking vaccines or other COVID-related medical attention is also expected as a result of this
- Subrecipient activities: a subset of the "activities to be performed" section, subrecipient activities will include transit operations including administration and maintenance; intercity service; and training. coordination of services will be ongoing and participation in programs and studies will also be included.

This project will utilize the full 5311 and 5311(f) apportionments of ARPA funding, the federal share of which is 100%.

It will be used to fund operations of 17 subrecipients across Nevada, including portions of operations incurred in direct response to the COVID-19 pandemic. No capital purchases will be made, although funds will be spent on preventive maintenance activities.

In addition to the separate 5311(f) apportionment, 15% of the standard 5311 apportionment is also being allocated to intercity operations.

The request has been developed based on FFY2022/2023 program years subrecipient awards, which will be funded with additional FTA funding awards.

Project Benefits

This project will benefit transit operators and the individuals who use it statewide. This funding will maintain reliable transit services, including intercity services, that provide increased mobility to the communities they serve, particularly as the state and nation recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. Application Executive Summary: This is an FFY 2021 Section 5311 ARP Act application in the amount of \$1,592,018. This total includes 5311(b)(3) (RTAP) and 5311(f) (intercity) apportionments. Per the ARP Act, the grant requests 100% federal share. This application utilizes ARP Act funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The application scope of work includes project admin, operations, preventive maintenance, for 17 current subrecipients to fund a portion of one months' service. It also includes RTAP and dedicated intercity projects for current subrecipients and one intercity contractor to fund approximately 80% of the fiscal year's operations. Any funds not expended according to projections will be reallocated and expended prior to the expiration of ARP Act apportionments in September 2024.

The breakdown of operating expenses provided below were derived by subrecipient agencies based on current and historical spending in the respective categories. Budget estimates also took into account inflation factors and other adjustments to costs based on the changing landscape of individual expenses (i.e., hiring additional staff, etc.).
