This grant application will be using lapsing funds in the amount of \$270,000.00 of FFY 2018 Discretionary Tribal Transit Program funding (D2018-TRTR-0023.

Purpose: Funds from this grant application will be used to build a new Transit Hub/Bus storage garage on the Seneca Nation's Cattaraugus Territory.

Activities to be performed: The funding from this application will be use to develop preliminary environmental screening, conceptual designs, architectural design, engineering design, construction drawings, and bid package documents for the Southern Tier Regional Transit Hub.

Expected Outcomes: The Southern Tier Regional Transit Hub (STRTH) project is to construct a new Transit Hub and Bus Storage Facility will enable improvements to public transportation provided by the Seneca Transit System. The STRTH will be designed to serve 20-30 customers waiting at one time and approximately three buses arriving at the site at any given time during the day. The STRTH will include parking areas for vehicles and buses, passenger ticketing functions, and passenger amenities.

Intended Beneficiaries: The Southern Tier Regional Transit Hub (STRTH) will support the expansion of transit services for the STS and regional partners. The bus storage facility portion of the STRTH will provide an area for interior storage of the buses operated by the STS on a daily basis. This project will enhance the Seneca Nation's ability to provide safe, accessible, coordinated, cost-effective and efficient public transportation services not only to our local communities, but to the entire region, and provide increased access to economic opportunities.

Project Benefits

The Southern Tier Regional Transit Hub (STRTH) will support the expansion of transit services for the STS and regional partners. The transit hub portion of the proposed project will serve as a transfer facility at which riders will be able to connect to buses that provide regional transit services including; STS, Chautauqua Area Regional Transit System (CARTS), Niagara Frontier Transportation Authority (NFTA), Coach USA, along with connections to public and private transit providers that visit the area (tour busses, casino/bingo hall busses). Once the STRTH construction is completed and operations commence, future services may allow riders to connect to other transit hubs across the country. Additionally, the exterior area surrounding the facility will include parking areas for vehicles and buses, passenger ticketing functions, and passenger amenities. The bus storage facility portion of the STRTH will provide an area for interior storage of the buses operated by the STS on a daily basis.

Additional Information

Additionally, the proposed facility will be engineered with the intention of converting the STS fleet to ecofriendly electric powered buses in the near future. The new electric powered fleet would cut fuel expenses and carbon emissions while expanding service intervals.

Location Description

The Seneca Nation is a Federally Recognized Native American Tribe and functions as an autonomous and sovereign Nation that provides a wide range of services and opportunities for its members and its communities. The Seneca Nation fully interprets its treaty-protected rights and sovereignty and, in turn, takes all efforts and avenues to create economic, social, and judicial sovereignty for its members. The Seneca Nation is listed in the January 29, 2021 Federal Register Notice published by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior, of tribal entities recognized and eligible for funding and services by virtue of their status as Indian Tribes.

The Cattaraugus Territory is located adjacent to portions of northern Cattaraugus County, southern Erie County, and northeastern Chautauqua County. This territory is geographically rural, located eight miles from the village of Gowanda, and forty miles south of the city of Buffalo. This proposed project area falls within the Greater Buffalo-Niagara Regional Transportation Council, Metropolitan Planning Organization service area.

The Southern Tier Regional Transit Hub (STRTH) will be located directly next to the Seneca One Stop, on U.S. Route 20/Southwestern Blvd, and have connection to NYS Route 5 on the opposite side of the location.
