The project of the Makah Public Transit will be on the Makah Reservation, which is located in Neah Bay on the northwestern tip of the Olympic Peninsula. The town of Neah Bay is the major population center on the reservation. There is only one highway into the Makah Reservation, SR 112, which connects Neah Bay to the rest of the Olympic Peninsula. The reservation is therefore isolated from other communities within Clallam County. Clallam County's major commercial center is Port Angeles, which is 75 miles from Neah Bay. Seattle is 150 miles away and Forks is 60 miles away. The remote location of the reservation and single roadway in-out proves to be a great disadvantage to accessibility to many services.
