Funding will be used for operating assistance and for internal project administration costs that will be included within operating assistance.

Activities to be performed - Funding will support the Bay Mills Public Transportation with operating assistance which will allow for the continued operation of the program and staff and also be used to offset expenses that include accounting, audit costs, and administrative oversight of the transit program.

Expected Outcomes: Continuation of program, retention of staff, and reliable transportation for users of BMPT.

Intended Beneficiaries: Beneficiaries will be the users of the Bay Mills Transportation System. This includes the community, elders, students, staff, business patrons, and guests in the community who wish to utilize BMPT.

There is no other public service transportation available in the Bay Mills Indian Community.
