Project Description

Tribal Transit funds will allocate (\$624,707.00) to operating of our existing services which include: Salaries for up to (18) full-time and two (2) on-call drivers, fuel, training and other eligible costs for our program needed to keep our services on-going. We will have a staff of (4) mechanics which are included in the staffing. Our transit system covers a nine (9) county area and serves those on and around our reserves.

Funding is based on need and availability of funds.

Project Benefits

Funding will be used for operating expenses to still add an additional fifth route to our existing services once all driver position are filled. Also to employ mechanics for our new maintenance building as we only have one lead mechanic hired at the present time. Our current services are open to the public and we do transports daily to and from medical, work, agency assistance and various appointments for passengers who do not have transportation and live in very rural areas.

Additional Information

Since Covid-19 is still active, we are still providing demand response services only but will be bringing back our fixed route services as our ridership numbers were greatly decreased due to this. We will see more of an increase in ridership once we bring back our fixed route system, since we will have the staff to transport more clients. With these two services, we will be able to serve more clients on a daily basis and purchase additional supplies to keep safe from the virus.

Location Description

Our existing services include nine (9) counties within the state that we currently access on a daily basis. The counties accessed are: Custer, Dewey, Beckham, Roger Mills, Blaine, Oklahoma, Canadian, Woodward and Kingfisher counties. We cover rural areas, as well as our metropolitan area where we have seen a greater ridership. We are still in the process of establishing a new fifth route to cover more area and to serve more patrons daily, once we are fully staffed.
