Application Executive Summary

This application is to request FY2020 Section 5311 Tribal Formula, CARES Act funds apportioned to the Pascua Yaqui Tribe (PYT), Arizona in the amount of \$64,118.

Purpose:

This application utilizes CARES Act funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The purpose of this grant for \$64,118 in Section 5311 CARES Act for the Pascua Yaqui Tribe is to provide operating funds for its contract with the City of Tucson, Sun Tran Bus Services, in the greater Tucson area for the period of January 20, 2020, through June 30, 2023.

Activities to be performed:

Funds will be used to support contracted Bus Services provided by Sun Tran for bus route number 29 from Casino del Sol through the Pascua Pueblo to downtown Tucson.

Expected Outcomes:

This transit service will benefit approximately 6,000 tribal community members on the remote reservation of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe (most of whom are low-income) providing them access to employment, medical appointments, educational training and other important meetings and tasks.

Intended Beneficiaries:

The benefits of this program will help the Tribe's community member who are dependent on public assistance. Currently, the Food Stamp recipient rate for the Tribe is 32.4%, almost three times higher than the State of Arizona at 11.2%. In addition, 43% of Tribal members live below 100% of the Federal Poverty Line, which is more than twice as high as the overall poverty rate for Arizona at 16%. Moreover, almost 71% of Tribal member live below 200% of the Federal Poverty Line, which is approximately three times higher than the overall poverty rate for Arizona at 24%. Consequently, a large proportion of the Tribe's population has no other transportation service except the Sun Tran bus line to go to medical appointments, employment, educational training or other important errands.

The Pascua Yaqui Tribe agrees that if it receives Federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or through a pass-through entity through the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, a different Federal agency, or insurance proceeds for any portion of a project activity approved for FTA funding under this Grant Agreement provided by FEMA, another Federal agency, or an insurance company, it will provide written notification to FTA, and reimburse FTA for any Federal share that duplicates funding.
