Application Executive Summary

This application is for FFY2021 Section 5311 ARP Act funds in the amount of \$5,903,510 that ODOT will award for intercity projects. ODOT is apportioned \$2,248,166 in FFY2021 ARP Act 5311 funding and \$3,655,344 in ARP 5311(f) funding specifically for intercity bus, all of which will be used in this grant. These projects will support COVID-19 emergency response and recovery and day-to-day operations of intercity bus systems that provide service to the communities in the state of Ohio. ARP Act funding is 100% Federal and no local match is necessary to be provided by the sub-recipients.

Purpose of the award: Support the COVID-19 emergency response and recovery and day-to-day operations of transit systems that provide critical service to the rural communities in the state of Ohio. Activities to be performed: In this award, there is one rural public transit system (Hocking Athens Perry Community Action-HAPCAP) being awarded funds for intercity operating expenses.

Expected outcomes: Transit operations will continue to operate through the COVID-19 pandemic and intercity bus service will be maintained.

Intended beneficiaries: One rural public transit system which provides intercity bus service. Subrecipient activities: All the work performed under this grant will be by sub-recipients. ODOT will not offer service ourselves.

Extended Budget Description

This award will provide funding to Ohio Intercity Bus Providers to support the emergency response and recovery to COVID-19 and day to day operations of intercity bus systems. In this award funds will be provided to HAPCAP who will be contracting with 3 companies (Greyhound Lines, Barons Bus, and Miller Transportation) to ensure that intercity bus service is provided in Ohio. Funds will be awarded from the 2021 ARP Act and will be used for operating expenses from 01/20/2021 through 12/31/2024 or until funds are exhausted.

This period of performance overlaps with the funding in other grants as that funding is not sufficient to cover all expenses. The following FAINS have overlap in periods of performance: 1225-2022-3 which is a 5311(f) formula grant and has a period of performance of 01/01/2022 through 12/31/2022, OH-2020-059-00 which is a 5311 CARES grant and has a period of performance of 01/20/2020 through 12/31/2022, and OH-2020-046-02 which is a 5311(f) formula grant and has a period of performance of 3/31/2021 through 12/31/2023. Note that all grants in question are for intercity operating purposes and have HAPCAP as the subrecipient.
