This application is to request Section 5311 FY 21 funds apportioned to the state of Oklahoma in the amount of \$17,383,636.

Purpose: The purpose of this award is to provide the state of Oklahoma and its subrecipients operating assistance, eligible capital projects, and for the rural transit assistance program (RTAP) for the state and its subrecipients.

Activities to be Performed: Funds will be used to cover eligible operating expenses such as driver salaries, fuel, items having a useful life of less than one year, and preventive maintenance, in order to continue transit operations. Funds will also be used to cover eligible capital expenses such as the purchase of two vans. Funds will also be used for training, technical assistance, and state administration.
