Purpose:

Wyoming DOT is applying for FFY2021 5311 Statewide funds in the amount of \$7,390,719 (full apportionment) and FFY2021 RTAP funds in the amount of \$106,899 (full apportionment). Total federal funding applied for: \$7,497,618. The funds will be used for public transportation providers in Wyoming for operating, project administration, preventive maintenance, intercity bus and RTAP funding for training, technical support and support services.
