Application Executive Summary

This application is to request FY2022 Section 5311 Tribal Transit Formula funds appointed to Blue Lake Rancheria, California in the amount of \$32,792.

Purpose: The purpose of this application is to assist with operational funds for retaining current transit employees. Operational funds will include expenses needed for fuel costs for the remaining year of FY22 and FY23. Lastly, operational funds will be used for assistance with the transit administration's operations.

Activities to be Performed: The activities that will be performed are to retain current transit operator positions within the Tribe as well as to fund any fuel costs and/or transit vehicle maintenance that may occur during the grant performance period.

Expected Outcomes: The outcomes of having this grant application approved will be to improve the Tribal Transit program by retaining employees and attracting qualified job applicants for open transit positions. The current wages that are in place are not competitive with jobs in this rural area.

Project Description

Operational Assistance for Blue Lake Rancheria Transit System (BLRTS), including \$32,792 in FY22, Tribal Transit Program (TTP) formula funds for tribal operating assistance under FAST.

Located in the State of California, Humboldt County, and adjacent to the City of Blue Lake; BLRTS provides over 19,000 one-way rides per year and offers a fixed, deviated route service in excess of 200 miles per day. Serving the areas of Blue Lake Rancheria (population 1,000+ daily/residential 203), and Community of Glendale (population 1,000+), City of Blue Lake (population 1,270), and City of Arcata (population 20,319). The system operates M-F 7AM-10AM/1PM-6PM (8 hours per day) offering public transportation opportunities with 1-2013, 28 passenger transit bus that is wheelchair accessible (mileage 216,189); 1-2014, 9 ambulatory/or, 7 ambulatory + 2 wheelchairs dial a ride van (mileage 41,949) and 1-2019, 28 passenger transit bus that is also wheelchair equipped (mileage 15,004).

The FY22 TTP formula funds will be used for operational assistance to keep BLRTS system operational and to connect passengers to the Arcata Transit Hub where transportation can be taken to virtually anywhere in the region.

Project Benefits

Having the BLRTS rural public transit system has improved livability in our service area by; - increasing mobility, - improved air and health quality with BLRTS green initiative, - decreased household transportation costs, - provided reliable access to employment, education, medical, and other services and basic needs, - providing public transit services community-wide, regardless of age, race, or income, - promoting collaboration/cooperation between many communities and agencies in support of public transit, - investing in our rural, healthy, safe and walkable neighborhoods, allowing them to prosper (economic development). Since 2000, the Tribe has provided rides for low-income citizens that live within the BLRTS service area through the Healthy Family Bus Pass Program. Applicants must qualify through established Policies & Procedures created by a planning committee. Applicants are vetted through the Blue Lake Family Resource Center to verify information obtained. Thirty passes are donated each month by the Tribe for distribution. This program allows riders who would not have transportation access otherwise to get to medical, employment, education, training, social and shopping venues.

Blue Lake Rancheria, California is located in rural Humboldt County, adjacent to the City of Blue Lake, 300 miles north of San Francisco along the California Coastal Ranges in the Mad River Valley, and where the two regional arteries of Highway 101 and Highway 299 intersect.
