#### **Application Executive Summary**

Amendment 01: This amendment adds the \$88,800 in 5311 referenced in the Original Award Executive Summary. TDOT is obligating \$88,800 in federal 5311 to this grant via amendment for use by First Tennessee Human Resource Agency to make improvements to the parking lot located at its maintenance facility. Details about the project are attached in Application Documents and included in the Extended Budget Description. FTA completed a NEPA review of the project and classified the project as CE#8. An email from FTA R04 staff is included in the Application Documents.

Five Elements

Purpose: This amendment adds the \$88,800 in federal 5311 to this grant via amendment for use by First Tennessee Human Resource Agency to make improvements to the parking lot located at its maintenance facility.

Activities to be Performed: The parking lot improvements include expanding the lot (grading and retention pond), paving, and electrical work for lighting and future infrastructure installments (electric charging station and bus wash)

Expected Outcomes: The project will result in a larger parking lot for the agency to store and maintain its fleet.

Intended Beneficiaries: First Tennessee Human Resource Agency

Subrecipient Activities: The subrecipient will work closely with TDOT to complete an FTA-compliant construction project and satisfactory continuing control.

TDOT will not obligate any of the FFY2022 apportionment to the 5311(f) Intercity Bus program. Following the comprehensive intercity bus consultation completed in June 2021, the attached Governor's Certification Letter notified FTA that intercity bus needs are being adequately met.

All subrecipients will follow useful life standards as defined in the TDOT State Management Plan.

TDOT will ensure contractors procured will not be on the FTA Suspension and Debarment list.

Award Executive Summary

This is a FFY2022 Section 5311 application in the federal amount of \$26,607,602, including Section 5311, Rural Technical Assistance Program, and Appalachian Development Public Transportation Assistance Program funds. This grant is a partial obligation of the FFY2022 Apportionment, which totals a federal amount of \$28,426,420. Of the \$26,607,602 obligated in this grant, Tennessee included the full Appalachian apportionment amount of \$1,457,357 and \$110,000 of the RTAP funds. Of the remaining funds, \$1,398,388 of State Administration and \$331,630 of RTAP funds will be obligated by TDOT in a separate, future grant. \$88,800 in 5311 will be obligated to this grant via amendment after TDOT and the subrecipient complete the NEPA work with FTA.

TDOT will not obligate any of the FFY2022 apportionment to the 5311(f) Intercity Bus program. Following the comprehensive intercity bus consultation completed in June 2021, the attached Governor's Certification Letter notified FTA that intercity bus needs are being adequately met.

Five Elements:

Purpose: The purpose of this award is to provide the state of Tennessee and its subrecipients operating assistance, eligible capital projects, and for the rural transit assistance program (RTAP) to assist the state and its subrecipients in providing public transportation in the rural and non-urbanized areas of Tennessee. Activities to be Performed: Funds will be used to cover eligible operating expenses for rural and non-urbanized public transportation. Funds will also be used to cover eligible capital expenses such as the purchase of passenger vehicles, support equipment, preventative maintenance, and mobility management programs. Funds will also be used for training and technical assistance.

Expected Outcomes: Continued safe and effective operation of transit services for rural areas of Tennessee, including Appalachian areas.

Intended Beneficiaries: State transit agencies and citizens in the rural and non-urbanized areas of the state.

Subrecipient Activities: Funds are allocated to 11 public agencies in the following categories: Project Administration, Capital, Operating, and RTAP.

This grant will provide funds to nine (9) rural public transportation systems for transportation in non-urban areas and two (2) rural transit-intensive agencies. The Appalachian funds are allocated to agencies serving Appalachian areas based on the 2010 Census. TDOT used the existing performance-based formula for the 5311 FFY2022 allocation. Factors for the formula include the 2010 Census non-urbanized population, public ridership, and public revenue miles.

The Operational Expenses requested in this application were determined by subrecipient budgeting processes. TDOT and its subrecipients understand that the expenses requested in this application are subject to review for their reasonableness as part of TDOT's State Management Review
