Tribal Transit Program funds will allocate (\$654,858.00) to operating of our existing services which include: Salaries for up to eleven (11) full-time and two (2) on-call drivers, fuel, training and other eligible costs for our program needed to keep our services on-going. Additionally, a portion of the funds (\$140,000.00) will also be used to purchase two (2) new (14) passenger buses to replace two (2) from the current fleet for our existing deviated fixed-route services which these two (2) vehicles have surpassed their useful lifespan and were purchased in 2016. Once we are able to obtain a full staff of drivers, we will be able to deploy our new fifth route. Our transit system covers a nine (9) county area and serves those on and around our reserves.

Project Benefits

Funding will be used for Operating expenses to add an additional fifth route to our existing services. The remaining funds will be used to purchase two (2) new vehicles to replace two (2) from the current aged fleet for our existing deviated fixed-route services. Our current services are open to the public and we do transports almost daily to and from medical, work, agency assistance and various appointments for passengers who do not have any transportation and live in very rural areas.

Additional Information

Over the last years, we have seen an increase in our ridership for each of our routes and with the addition of a new fifth route, this would greatly increase ridership more. This route changes will make it easier for all passengers from all routes we serve to access more of the many agencies that are currently not accessible to them in the very rural areas which is a much needed service on a daily basis.

Location Description

Our existing services include nine (9) counties within the state that we currently access on a daily basis. We cover rural areas, as well as our metropolitan area where we have seen a great increase in ridership within the last years. We currently have four (4) routes that cover a number of towns and locations each day and we are still in the process of establishing a new route to cover more area and to serve more patrons daily, once we are fully staffed.
