

Worker Health Protection Program (WHPP)

Medical Screenings:

- Screenings may include: physical exam, chest x-ray with b-read, blood test, breathing test, beryllium test, urinalysis, and hearing test.
- Participants at the highest risk of lung cancer (based on age, work history, and smoking history) are invited to receive Low Dose CT Scans from the WHPP Early Lung Cancer Detection Program (ELCD)

Eligibility:

• Former workers of Mound and Fernald (post-1986) with at least 30 days in a non-building trade. Participants are eligible for rescreen examinations every three years.

Screening Locations:

- Mound: Concentra (Dayton and Franklin, Ohio)
- Fernald: Mercy Health (Fairfield, OH) and McCullough Hyde Urgent Care (Oxford, OH)

Screening Numbers:

Former workers screened: Fernald= 998, Mound= 1,514 Exams (including re-screens):

Fernald= 2,392, Mound=3,442

Former workers screened for lung cancer:

Fernald=463, Mound=620

Low-dose CT scans completed: Fernald= 1810,

Mound=2068
