Presenters' Biographies:

Dr. Marek Mikulski is the Director of the Former Burlington Atomic Energy Commission Plant and Ames Laboratory Worker Medical Screening Program and an Adjunct Assistant Professor with the Department of Occupational and Environmental Health, College of Public Health at the University of Iowa. He received his MPH and PhD degrees from the University of Iowa and specializes in occupational epidemiology research and studies on health effects of exposures in nuclear and conventional munitions production. Dr. Mikulski has served on the DOL's Advisory Board on Toxic Substances and Worker Health since 2018.

Dr. Mary Townsend is an Independent Spirometry and Epidemiology Consultant for industrial, government, and research clients and an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Environmental and Occupational Health at the Graduate School of Public Health, University of Pittsburgh. She earned a BA in Chemistry from Case Western Reserve University and a DrPH in Epidemiology from the University of Pittsburgh Graduate School of Public Health. Dr. Townsend consults for OSHA's Directorate of Standards and Guidance and helped develop the Spirometry Testing in Occupational Health Programs: Best Practices for Healthcare Professionals Guidance Document, released on March 27, 2013. She is lead author of ACOEM's Position Statements on Spirometry in the Occupational Health Setting - most recently written in 2020, and has been an active member of the American Thoracic Society (ATS) for over 40 years.
