



# How to Bill for Home Health Care (HHC) Services

## NEW CODES AS OF DECEMBER 17, 2022

On December 17, 2022, the Division of Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation (DEEOIC) changed how HHC services are reimbursed. Specifically, DEEOIC changed the procedure codes that are utilized for billing.

Providers are to submit bills in accordance with the procedure codes outlined in the approval letter and the dates of service authorized in the letter. **HHC Authorizations approved on/after December 17, 2022, are billed using the following NEW procedure codes:**

<b>Home Health Aide (HHA) Certified Nurses Assistant (CAN) Personal Care Attendant (PCA)</b>	<b>S9122 - 1 unit = 1 hour</b> (Max units that can be billed are 24 units/24 hours per day)	<b>T1019 - 1 unit = 15 mins</b> (Max units that can be billed are 3 units/ 45 mins per day, week, or month based on the frequency of the hourly code)
<b>Registered Nurse (RN) Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)</b>	<b>S9123/S9124 - 1 unit = 1 hour</b> (Max units that can be billed are 24 units/24 hours per day)	<b>G0299/G0300 - 1 unit = 15 mins</b> (Max units that can be billed are 3 units/ 45 mins per day, week, or month based on the frequency of the hourly code)
<b>Home Hospice Services</b>	<b>T2043 - 1 unit = 1 hour</b> (Max units that can be billed are 24 units/24 hours per day)	<b>G0156 - 1 unit = 15 mins</b> (Max units that can be billed are 3 units/ 45 mins per day, week, or month based on the frequency of the hourly code)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Authorization is for 12 hours per day/7 days per week</li> <li>• Provider renders 12 hours per day/7 days per week</li> <li>• Provider submits bill for 12 units of the hourly code for each day of service rendered</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Authorization is for 2 hours per week</li> <li>• Provider renders 1 hour and 30 mins for that week</li> <li>• Provider submits bill for 1 unit of the hourly code and 2 units of the quarterly (15 min) code</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Authorization is for 49 hours per week</li> <li>• Provider renders 46 hours and 45 mins for that week</li> <li>• Provider submits bill for 46 units of the hourly code and 3 units of the quarterly (15 min) code</li> </ul>

<b>Home Health Aide (HHA) Certified Nurses Assistant (CNA)</b>	<b>S9122 - 1 unit = 1 hour</b> (Max units that can be billed are 7 units/7 hours per day)	<b>S5126 - 1 unit = 8 hours</b> (Max units that can be billed are 3 units/ 24 hours per day)
<b>Registered Nurse (RN) Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)</b>	<b>S9123/S9124 - 1 unit = 1 hour</b> (Max units that can be billed are 7 units/7 hours per day)	<b>T1030/T1031 - 1 unit = 8 hours</b> (Max units that can be billed are 3 units/ 24 hours per day)
<b>Personal Care Attendant (PCA)</b>	<b>T1019 - 1 unit = 15 mins</b> (Max units that can be billed are 31 units/7 hours and 45 mins per day)	<b>T1020 - 1 unit = 8 hours</b> (Max units that can be billed are 3 units/ 24 hours per day)
<b>Home Hospice Services</b>	<b>S9126 - 1 unit = 8 hours</b> (Max units that can be billed are 1 unit/8 hours per day)	

<b>POST-DECEMBER 17, 2022 BILLING EXAMPLES</b>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Authorization is for 12 hours per day/7 days per week</li> <li>• Provider renders 12 hours per day/7 days per week</li> <li>• Provider submits bill for 1 unit of the per diem code and 4 units of the hourly code for each day of services rendered</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Authorization is for 8 hours per day/ 7days per week</li> <li>• Provider renders 8 hours per day for 5 days and 7 hours for 2 days</li> <li>• Provider submits bill for 5 units of the per diem code for the 5 days where 8 hours of services were rendered and 14 units of the hourly code for the 2 days where less than 8 hours of services were rendered</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Authorization is for 3 hours per day/ 4 days per week</li> <li>• Provider renders 3 hours per day/ 4 days per week</li> <li>• Provider submits bill for 3 units of the hourly code for each day when services were rendered</li> </ul>

**Note:** S5126, S9126, T1020, T1030, and T1031 were retired from use in future authorizations for reimbursement of HHC Services on December 17, 2022 and are only available for billing purposes for authorizations approved prior to that date. Codes G0153, G0299, G0300, and T2043 are available for use in approved authorizations for reimbursement of HHC Services on or after December 17, 2022.



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
