Digital X-ray Rule – Date Applicability

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: To ensure that claims are treated consistently at the district director level, DCMWC needs to clarify when the procedures explained in Bulletin #14-08 (which explains how digital X-rays should be evaluated under the revised regulations) apply.

References:

BLBA Bulletin #14-08, Digital X-rays, dated June 2, 2014.

Applicability:

DCMWC District Directors and appropriate DCMWC Personnel.

Action:

DCMWC claims personnel must handle X-ray readings as follows:

- 1. If the claim was filed on or after May 19, 2014: Bulletin #14-08 applies to all digital X-ray readings.
- 2. If the claim was filed before May 19, 2014:
 - Bulletin #14-08 applies to digital X-ray readings made on or after May 19, 2014 (this refers to the date of the reading, not the date the X-ray was taken).
 - Bulletin #14-08 does not apply to digital X-ray readings made before May 19, 2014. Those X-rays are evaluated under 20 C.F.R. § 718.107. Any reading based on a converted X-ray should not be considered because it is not medically acceptable or reliable evidence. If the reading is not based on a converted X-ray, it should be treated like digital X-ray evidence before the revised regulations were issued.

<u>Disposition</u>: Retain this Bulletin until further notice or its incorporation into the Black Lung Benefits Procedure Manual.
