Dear Mr. Boulton:

This office has recently completed an audit of Steelworkers Local 11-9317-S under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you on May 13, 2008, the following problems were disclosed during the CAP. The matters listed below are not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

Reporting Violations

The audit disclosed a violation of LMRDA Section 201(b), which requires labor organizations to file annual financial reports accurately disclosing their financial condition and operations. The Labor Organization Annual Report, Form LM-3, required from Local 11-9317-S for fiscal year ending December 31, 2007 had not been filed. In addition, a terminal LM-3 report had not been filed for the period of January 1, 2008 up to the date of Local 11-9317-S' termination, January 31, 2008. During the audit, you completed both reports and submitted them to the St. Louis District Office.
