**Whereas**, the Shelley-Maloney Apprentice Labor Standards Act created the California Apprenticeship Council (CAC) as the apprenticeship policy making body for the State of California; and

**Whereas**, apprenticeship has been recognized over centuries as a tried and true method of passing on essential skills from one generation of skilled crafts persons to another; and

**Whereas**, the apprenticeship system remains as effective today as ever in meeting the changing needs of California's employers for well-trained, highly skilled labor in 306 occupations in a wide range of industries; and


**Whereas**, apprenticeship offers Californians a pathway to a well-paying lifelong career, with industry-recognized credentials, without incurring student loan debt; and

**Whereas**, with over 73,000 registered apprentices California is the largest apprenticeship system in the country that is highly diverse with a substantial number of woman, veterans, minorities, encompassing all ethnic groups; and

**Whereas**, the California apprenticeship system continues to grow, expand, and innovate. California also enjoys non-partisan support for apprenticeship with an appropriation from the state for the purpose of partially offsetting costs necessary to train all California apprentices; and

**Whereas**, President Obama has declared the week of November 14 - 20, 2016, the second annual "National Apprenticeship Week" that provides the Apprenticeship community the opportunity to recognize success stories of apprentices, businesses, education, and other entities that contribute to Apprenticeship;
