WHEREAS: Arkansas has 93 Registered Apprenticeship programs involving hundreds of employers and approximately 4,664 Registered Apprentices, and they continue to grow; and

WHEREAS: Management, labor, the US Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship, Arkansas Department of Career Education for Apprenticeship and Construction, Training Career and Technical Education Division, Arkansas Department of Higher Education, Arkansas Department of Corrections, Arkansas Department of Workforce Development, secondary technical education, and postsecondary education have joined hands to promote and expand Registered Apprenticeship; and
