Proclamation

WHEREAS; THE NATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP ACT, ALSO KNOWN AS THE FITZGERALD ACT, BECAME LAW IN 1937 AND REGULATES APPRENTICESHIP AND ON-THE-JOB TRAINING PROGRAMS IN OUR COUNTRY; AND

WHEREAS; THROUGH PUBLIC-PRIVATE INVESTMENT AND PARTNERSHIPS, OVER 2,000 LAS VEGAS RESIDENTS ARE CURRENTLY IN REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS IN A WIDE VARIETY OF CAREERS INCLUDING: MACHINE REPAIR, TOOL AND DIE, FACILITY MAINTENANCE, ELECTRICIAN, INSULATION WORKER, OPERATING ENGINEER, PLUMBER, PAINTER, AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS TECHNICIAN; AND

WHEREAS; THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS ENCOURAGES EFFORTS TO STRENGTHEN AND DIVERSIFY THE ECONOMY OF SOUTHERN NEVADA AS WELL AS EFFORTS THAT ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THOSE WHO LIVE, LEARN, WORK, AND PLAY IN OUR COMMUNITY;

WHEREAS; NATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP WEEK OFFERS LEADERS IN BUSINESS, LABOR, EDUCATION, WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, AND OTHER CRITICAL COMMUNITY PARTNERS THE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPRESS THEIR SUPPORT FOR REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP AND PROVIDES STAKEHOLDERS WITH QUALITY APPRENTICESHIPS A CHANCE TO SHOWCASE THEIR PROGRAMS, FACILITIES, AND APPRENTICES; NOW
