WHEREAS, the demand for skilled workers continues to increase. Registered Apprenticeship training is a proven method to meet this demand and helps Wyoming prepare for economic development and economic growth; and

WHEREAS, Apprenticeship USA combines on-the-job training with theoretical instruction to a diverse population; and

WHEREAS, today in Wyoming, over 85 employers and associations sponsor Registered Apprenticeship training to 337 active apprentices; and

WHEREAS, over the years, thousands of individuals in Wyoming have completed their registered apprenticeship in both union and non-union programs; and

WHEREAS, Wyoming employers have participated in Apprenticeship USA since the late 1930's turning out skilled workers with rewarding careers.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MATTHEW H. MEAD, Governor of the State of Wyoming, do hereby proclaim the week of November 14 – 20, 2016 as
