

DOL AGENCIES



VETERANS PREFERENCE STATUS

Military Service is not considered in all cases for the purpose of Federal civilian employment, and not all-active duty service is qualifying for veterans' preference. Only veterans discharged or released from active duty in the armed forces under honorable or general (under honorable) conditions are eligible for veterans preference. If you are a "Retired" member of the armed forces, you are not a preference eligible veteran unless you are a disabled veteran OR you retired below the rank of O-4.

There are two types of preference eligibles, disabled (10 point preference eligibles) and non-disabled (5 point preference eligibles):

You are a 5 point preference eligible if your active duty service meets any of the following:

- 180 or more consecutive days, any part of which occurred during the period beginning September 11, 2001 and ending on a future date prescribed by Presidential proclamation or law as the last date of Operation Iraqi Freedom, OR
- Between August 2, 1990 and January 2, 1992, OR
- 180 or more consecutive days, any part of which occurred after January 31, 1955 and before October 15, 1976.
- In a war, campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized or between April 28, 1952 and July 1, 1955.

You are a 10 point preference eligible if you served at any time, and you:

- have a service connected disability, OR
- received a Purple Heart.

VETERAN HIRING AUTHORITIES

Veterans' Recruitment Appointment (VRA)

VRA eligibility applies to the following categories:

- Disabled veterans;
- Veterans who served on active duty in the Armed Forces during a war declared by Congress, or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized;
- Veterans who, while serving on active duty in the Armed Forces, participated in a military operation for which the Armed Forces Service Medal was awarded; and Veterans separated from active duty within 3 years.

Veterans Employment Opportunities Act of 1998 (VEOA)

VEOA eligibility applies to the following categories of veterans:

- Preference eligibles; (listed above)
- and Service personnel separated after 3 or more years of continuous active service performed under honorable conditions.
