

Upon consideration of the record herein, and as agreed to by the Secretary and Defendants, the Court finds that it has jurisdiction to enter this Consent Judgment and Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Defendant Helmick shall restore to the Plan participants \$208.44 in assets plus \$69.23 in lost opportunity costs. The \$277.67 shall be allocated on a pro-rata basis to the Plan participants. Such amounts shall be paid directly to each participant via certified check.

Defendant Helmick shall provide to the Secretary proof of the payments made. Such proof shall be submitted within ten (10) business days after payment to the following: Joe Rivers, Regional Director, U.S. Department of Labor, EBSA, 1885 Dixie Highway, Suite 210, Ft. Wright, KY 41011.

2. All costs or fees associated with the actions described in paragraph Number 1 above shall be paid by Defendant Helmick;

3. Upon termination of the Plan, Defendant Helmick shall be permanently barred from serving or acting as fiduciary or service provider with respect to any employee benefit plan subject to ERISA.

4. Each party to this Consent Judgment and Order agrees to bear his/her/its own attorneys' fees, costs and other expenses incurred by such party in connection with any stage of this proceeding, including attorneys' fees which may be available under the Equal Access to Justice Act, as amended.

5. The Court retains jurisdiction for purposes of enforcing compliance with the terms of this Consent Judgment and Order.


6. Nothing in this Consent Judgment and Order is binding on any government agency other than the United States Department of Labor, Employee Benefits Security Administration.


